Tune:	<i>O Jesu Christ, meins Lebens Licht, Leipzig 1625</i>
Text:	Aria: "Nur getrost, getrost, ihr Herzen, / hier ist Angst, dort Herrlichkeit! / Und die Freude jener Zeit / überwieget alle Schmerzen." Chorale (V. 2 of the hymn <i>O Jesu Christ, meins Lebens Licht</i> ): "Ich hab vor mir ein schwere Reis / zu dir ins Himmels Paradeis, / da ist mein rechtes Vaterland, / daran du dein Blut hast gewandt."
Originally scored for:	B., S. (c.f.), ob. I-II, taille (ob. da caccia), stgs. & cont.
Transcribed as:	A trio movement for organ with c.f. in the pedal (2'; range: from G to f). The accompanying voices can eventually be played on one manual, and the c.f. can on many organs be played with a 4' stop an octave higher).
Key in the cantata:	C Major
Key in the transcription:	C Major
Comments:	Apart from the reduction of the number of voices only few changes have been made.
