Text:	"Herr, gib, dass ich dein Ehre / ja all mein Leben lang / von Herzensgrund vermehre, / dir sage Lob und Dank! / O Vater, Sohn und Geist, / der du aus lauter Gnade / abwendest Not und Schaden, / sei immerdar gepreist."
Originally scored for:	Choir, Corno da caccia col Soprano, Flauto I-II e Oboe I coll'Alto, Oboe d'amore II col Tenore, stgs. & cont.
Transcribed as:	A movement for organ with c.f. in the left hand.
Key in the cantata:	B minor
Key in the transcription:	B minor
Comments:	The number of voices has been reduced to 4. I have notated the cantus firmus an octave lower than Bach did, and some notes have been changed in order to avoid parallels which would be easily heard in a transcription.
