System 3 (Measures 9-12):

- Violin I:** Measures 9-10 contain a melody starting on G4, moving up stepwise to D5, then down to C5. Measure 11 has a whole rest. Measure 12 has a whole rest.
- Violin II:** Measures 9-10 have whole rests. Measures 11-12 contain a melody starting on G3, moving up stepwise to D4, then down to C4.
- Violin III:** Measures 9-12 have whole rests.

Dynamic markings:

- Violin I:** *mp* (measures 1-2), *p* (measures 5-6).
- Violin II:** *mp* (measures 3-4), *mp* (measures 7-8).
- Violin III:** *p* (measures 5-6), *mp* (measures 9-10).
