DAVID BRANSON

— a new English composer

THE OXFORD UNIVERSITY PRESS has pleasure in announcing the issue of the first published works of David Branson.

Known as a pianist through his frequent broadcasts, David Branson has hitherto not come forward as a composer. But it is believed that the first list of six works given below will be representative of his varied talents, and of such a kind as at once to endear him to the public.

This is music with melody, with charm but not lacking in depth, technically skilful for the medium of the moment. The solo songs are in the best tradition of the modern English song—faithful to the words in a degree that almost dictates the musical form and yet avoids mere declamation. The junior piano pieces are as simple as they are strikingly musical. And everyone will surely have the *Hiking Tune* running in his head before long!

The composer is also the designer of the cover.
