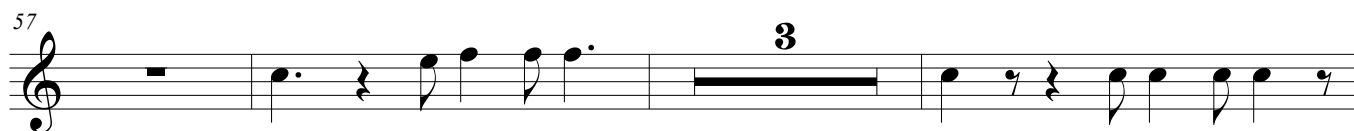

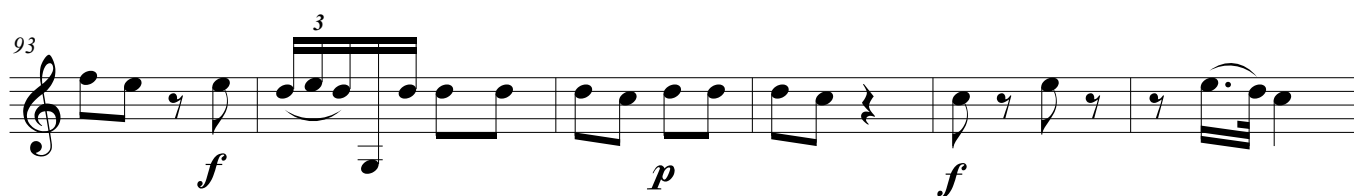

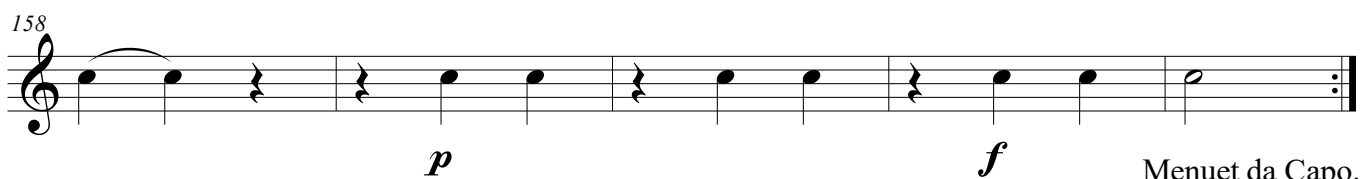
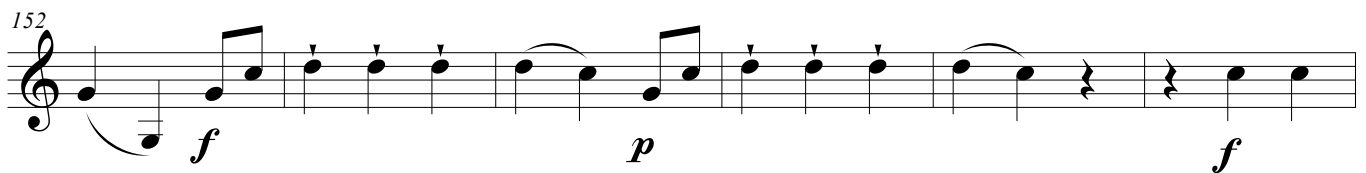
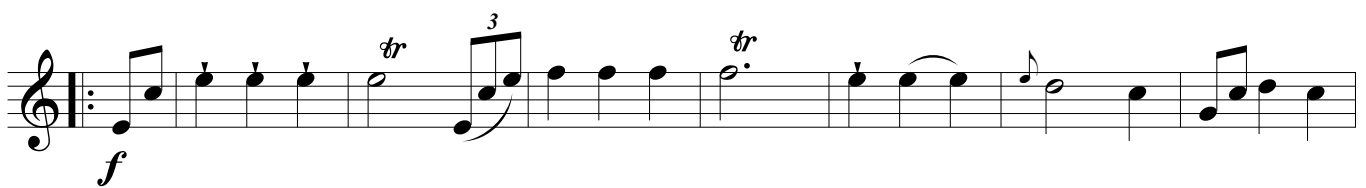


Menuet.
