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## INTRODUCTION

This is a dance suite music piece. It has three movements, Penelope's Song, Bigot's Dance and Penelope's Feast. It is based on a folk story. This piece is 12 minutes long. It is written in 3 movements, 26 pages. It is written for French Horn, Violoncello and Piano.

## EPISODE

The word goes around that Penelope, a young girl named the Devil by the locals, stood away from them and lived a mystical life on a hilltop at Ayvalık. When a famine began in the village the elderly and religious leaders pointed at Penelope as the cause of the famine and called them to go and lynch her. Penelope got help from a shepherd and decided to prepare a perfact feast. People who came to kill Penelope were so hungry that they could not stop themselves from eating the delicious food and enjoy the marvelous scenery. It was a true feast. In the mean time, Penelope made her way out to safety.

From that time on, this hilltop at Ayvalık was called the Devil's Feast.

## ANALYSIS

This piece is based on a single 12 tone series. Its retrograde, inversion and retrograde inversion are also used. These series are also used in the form of their reductions to $2,3,4$ pitches by skipping a number of $1,2,3,4$ etc. pitches. The beginning and ending parts of these series are also used instead of the whole series.
