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Colla, Giuseppe: *Odo il pianto* : Kantate für Sopran, Streicher und zwei Hörner

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Giuseppe Colla (* 1731 oder 1739, † 1806) lebte und wirkte überwiegend in Parma. Ab 1766 war als *maestro di cappella* in der herzoglichen Kapelle angestellt, und von 1780 bis zu seinem Tode nahm er zusätzlich den Posten des Konzertmeisters am *Teatro Ducale* ein. Für seine Frau, die gefeierte Sopranistin Lucrezia Agujari, komponierte Colla viele Werke, die sie auf gemeinsamen Konzertreisen aufführten. Es ist durchaus nicht unwahrscheinlich, dass Colla bei der dramatischen Kantate *Odo il pianto* seine Frau als Sängerin im Blick hatte.

Die vorliegende Komposition ist im *Répertoire International des Sources Musicales* zwar nur in der Fürstlich zu Bentheim-Tecklenburgischen Musikbibliothek Rheda nachgewiesen, höchstwahrscheinlich ist sie jedoch musikalisch identisch mit der in Stockholm überlieferten Kantate *Vadan Molda ed Elba*. Genaue Untersuchungen zur historischen, musikalischen und textlichen Verbindung dieser beiden Werke stehen noch aus.
