## Introduction

*Quarantine Songs* were written over a one-month period during the beginning of the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic in Buffalo, New York, a spontaneous collaboration between the Menagerie Trio and me. The trio was confined to their home, while my wife, and daughter—who became stranded during what was originally *supposed* to be a 10-day visit—were likewise confined along with me, albeit comfortably, in the spacious home of a friend from whom I was renting a room that semester.

The primary material in both “Courting Dance” and “Goodbye Song” come from a pocket notebook I which sketched between (and admittedly, sometimes during) classes at the American School in Puerto Montt, where I was a general music teacher for two cherished years. The other two songs were written “to order”.

In all four I have employed a vernacular musical language and simple song forms. The style is almost always spontaneous and light, with an emphasis on melody and texture; in other words, music that was meant to be a pleasure to write, a pleasure to perform, and a pleasure to listen to. Enjoy.

## About the Composer

Edgar Girtain (b. 1988) is originally from the United States. His formal training began at Ithaca college, and continued later at Rutgers University, where he earned a bachelor’s degree in Music Education and a master’s degree in Composition and Music Theory.

Between 2012 and 2016 he worked as a freelance musician around New York, teaching in public schools and holding an organist’s post at an Episcopal Church in Allendale, New Jersey. In 2017 he relocated to Puerto Montt, Chile to teach at the private K-12 “American School.”

## Introducción

*Quarantine Songs* se escribieron durante un período de un mes durante el comienzo de la pandemia COVID-19 de 2020 en Buffalo, Nueva York, una colaboración espontánea entre Menagerie Trio y yo. El trío estuvo confinado en su casa, mientras que mi esposa y mi hija, que quedaron varadas durante lo que originalmente se suponía que sería una visita de 10 días, también estuvieron confinadas conmigo, aunque cómodamente, en la espaciosa casa de un amigo de a quien alquilaba una habitación ese semestre.

El material principal tanto de “Courting Dance” como de “Goodbye Song” proviene de un cuadernito que bosquejé entre (y, ciertamente, a veces durante) clases en el American School de Puerto Montt, donde fui profesor de música en aula durante dos queridos años. Las otras dos canciones fueron escritas "por encargo".

En los cuatro he empleado un lenguaje musical vernáculo y formas de canciones sencillas. El estilo es casi siempre espontáneo y ligero, con énfasis en la melodía y la textura; en otras palabras, música que debía ser un placer de escribir, un placer de interpretar y un placer de escuchar. Disfruten.

## Sobre el compositor

Edgar Girtain (nacido en 1988) proviene de los Estados Unidos. Su entrenamiento formal comenzó en la universidad Ithaca, y continuó luego en la Universidad de Rutgers, donde obtuvo una licenciatura en Educación Musical y un posgrado en Composición y Teoría de la Música.

Entre 2012 y 2016 trabajó como músico independiente en Nueva York, enseñando en escuelas públicas y ocupando el puesto de organista en una Iglesia Episcopal en Allendale, Nueva Jersey. En 2017 se mudó a Puerto Montt, Chile, para enseñar en Colegio privado "The American School".
