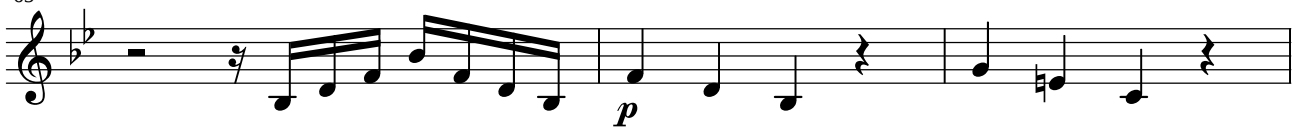

Adagio tacet**Allegro**
