A collection of Canticles and Antiphones of our Lady, set to music by eminent composers; besides 12 *O Salutaris* and *Tantum Ergo*, for the Benediction of the most Blessed Sacrament. Approved by Archbishop Williams.

CANTUS DIVINUS. By A. H. ROSEWIG.
Boards, \$2.75.

This book is very highly recommended by the Archbishop of Philadelphia. It is widely known and used, has a large variety of Catholic music, and there is nothing in its 300 pages which could well be spared.

CATHOLIC CHOIR BOOK (The); or Morning and Evening Service. By R. GARRET.

Price, \$2.25.

Compiled by direction of Bishop Fenwick of Boston. It has an elementary course for beginners, and provides music for every occasion of service in the Catholic church.

CATHOLIC CHOIR (PETERS'). Compiled and arranged by WM. DRESSLER. In 2 vols., each, \$3.50.

These two books are similar in size and appearance, and contain besides several fine masses and vespers of considerable length, an abundance of good and popular music, fitted for all occasions where a choir may be needed.

CATHOLIC CLASS BOOK (PETERS'). WM. DRESSLER. 75 cents.

A music book for Catholic schools, with good secular and sacred (Catholic) music.

CATHOLIC HARMONIST (PETERS'). W. C. PETERS. Price, \$1.50.

A collection of Motets, Masses, Hymns and Chants for morning and evening service, suitable for the principal Festivals during the year. The music is easy, and within the reach of ordinary singers, and intended for small choirs.

CATHOLIC HARP (PETERS'). Compiled by W. C. PETERS. \$1.25.

A collection of sacred music designed for the use of choirs, schools and musical associations. It is highly commended by Archbishop Purcell, of Cincinnati, and contains 175 pages, well filled with a general collection of Catholic music, most of which is easy to sing, and all of the best quality.

CATHOLIC MELODIST (PETERS'). WM. DRESSLER. Price, \$1.50.

This book has the usual number of hymns to the Blessed Virgin, vespers, hymns, etc., arranged for female voices, with an occasional bass part, ad. lib.

CATHOLIC VOCALIST. 5 Numbers; each 50 cents. H. T. ROCHOLL.

Litanies, anthems, motets, chants, etc., for church service, for school, and for the family circle, with piano or organ accompaniment.

LYRA CATHOLICA. WILCOX and SOUTHARD. Boards, \$2.50; cloth, \$2.75.

A collection of masses, motets, hymns, etc., for use at all times with responses complete, arranged for large and small choirs.

MARIA IMMACULATA. E. J. DOOLEY. Boards, \$2.25; cloth, \$2.50.

This book has no masses, but supplies the omission with pleasing and brilliant music, appropriate to different parts of the service.

MAY BLOSSOMS. 40 cents.

A collection of hymns to the Blessed Virgin, compiled and arranged by the Sisters of Notre Dame, Cincinnati, O. All the hymns are in the English language and are adapted for schools, but have no accompaniment.

MAY CHIMES. Price, \$1.25.

This book contains the same songs as in "May Blossoms," with full piano or organ accompaniment.

MEMORARE (THE). ANTHONY WERNER. Price \$2.75.

This book contains six masses, a short requiem mass, vespers and other miscellaneous pieces, with piano or organ accompaniment. Recommended by the Bishop of Boston.

MORNING SERVICE (PETERS'). W. C. PETERS. Price, \$3.50.
