ELEN CRAMM, one of the most successful composers of music for beginners, is a well known New England musician. Her musical ability, inherited from her father, was manifested at an early age.

When a very small girl, Miss Cramm began the

study of singing. It was not long, however, before she specialized in piano playing. In this branch, as well as in organ playing, she had the advantage of studying with several excellent teachers. Miss Cramm taught music privately and also at the Montpelier, Vermont, Seminary, and established a school of music in Haverhill, Mass., her home city.

The first compositions of Miss Cramm's to attract public notice were published in 1905. Since that time she has written several volumes of piano music. That these may be classed among the best sellers is evidenced by the fact that the demand for her music is not merely confined to this country, but reaches to such far off lands as China and Japan. But let Miss Cramm speak for herself:

"I have numerous interests beside that of music; belong to several clubs, musical and social, of which I have at different times been president, director, speaker, etc.; am not now actively engaged in teaching, but do more or less coaching and am director of music at St. John's Episcopal Church. My house is a social and musical center.

"My love of children makes my work a pleasure. I am a great lover of Nature, and during the growing season spend two or three hours a day cultivating flowers, vegetables and fruits about my place; and then, having in my pedigree many generations of old New England housewives, I can, and can, and can—enough for three families like my own, which includes only an old housekeeper which I inherited."



THIS method has been written primarily to make easier the task of the young pupil, so that he may be assisted at home in, at least, the mental preparation of his first lessons. At the same time, it actually simplifies the work of the teacher, especially with beginners, as each of four lessons is clearly outlined with special reference to "mental" preparation.

The first part of this method consists entirely of elementary work: muscular relaxation, technical and mental application. The first, and most important steps are so provided for that their mastery is made easily possible. Care has been taken in the selection of suitable study material and pieces, so as to incite the pupil's interest and to form his musical taste.
